Take the self-guided tours between Ellis Island and Statue of Liberty at your leisure. We suggest the following schedule:

- From Liberty State Park, take the ferry to Ellis Island. Please note that there will be airport-style security lines.
- The self-guided audio tour of Ellis Island can be completed in about two hours. While there, you may have lunch on your own at the café. (total time in Ellis Island may be approx. 2-3 hours).
- From Ellis Island, take the ferry to the Statue of Liberty (Liberty Island). Take the self-guided audio tour that can be completed in under an hour. Our tickets do not include access inside the statue (total time at Statue of Liberty may be approx. 1 hour).
- From Statue of Liberty (Liberty Island), take the 4:10 or 4:40 ferry back to Liberty State Park, NJ to be ready for a 5:30 bus departure back to Glastonbury.
